will probably answer.

1. Teaspoonful of spirit of Mentherium.
10. Drops of tincture of Henbane.
7. Drops of tincture of flowers of Colchicum.
Two table spoonful of Camphor mixture
Mixed and taken at bed time.

20. Drops of tincture of Henbane
15. grains of Bi-Carbonate of Soda.
12. Drops of tincture of Colchicum
Camphor mixture.

Take of His Royal Highness The Prince Consort.

Compound Chalk Powder 15 grains

Powdered Rhubarb 6 grains

Compound Tincture of Cardamoms one dram

Cinnamon Water nine drachms

Mix

Make into a draught.

This draught to be taken when the bowels are disturbed, & disposed to diarrhoea.

For correcting acidity
a Saline Draught
½ powder of Bicarb. Soda
20 drops of Salvolatile

To make the Khabab
draught -

Rub up ten grains of Khabab
two grains of soda &
ten grains of sugar
with one drop of
oil of nutmeg -
