

## Biography of Mary Longbottom

B c. 1820, D 1892

Mary Longbottom was an inmate in the Leeds Union Workhouse on the night of the 1881 Census (1). She was born in Kirkburton, near Huddersfield, was 60 years old and had worked as a Woollen Weaver.

In 1891, Mary was a patient in the Leeds Union Infirmary, Beckett St, Leeds, and died there the following year (2,3). She was buried on 24 August 1892 in the Anglican section of the Beckett St Cemetery, aged 71.

Mary could not be traced on the earlier Census years and nothing is known of her pre-Workhouse life.
