

More Than Oliver Twist: Biography

Name: Elizabeth Fannon

B. 1818, d. 1885

According to her census return for Leeds Union Workhouse in 1881, Elizabeth Fannon was born in Ireland in 1818 (1). She was a Charwoman, aged 63, and a widow. She possibly cleaned the Workhouse.

Elizabeth died in Leeds in 1885 (2) and was buried from Leeds Union Infirmary in Beckett Street Cemetery on 22 July that year (3). The record describes her as the widow of John.

No other convincing records could be found.
